


STI AND STBBI - WHAT'S THE DIFFERENCE?

Sexually Transmitted Infections (STI) •

STIs are characterized by the way they pass between two people – through sexual contact. There are very few instances where these infections can be passed without sexual contact. Remember – sexual contact is anytime there is touching of the intimate parts (genitals) of one or both people involved. Herpes can also be passed through kissing.



Sexually Transmitted Blood Borne Infections (STBBI)

STBBIs are characterized by the way they pass between two people (sexual contact) AND by the body fluid they are found in (the blood). STBBIs can be passed between two people in more ways than through sexual contact, including any items with someone else blood on them or any items that have pierced the skin of another person.

SIMILARITIES AND DIFFERENCES

STIs

- Passed through sexual contact
- Mainly affects the area used during sexual contact
- Tested for using urine or swabs

STBBIs

- Passed through sexual contact and the transfer of blood
- Travels through the blood to affect the whole body
- Tested for using blood (draw or drops)

TESTING TIMELINE

Testing Day

Swabs or urine taken for chlamydia and gonorrhea. Swab or blood taken for herpes.
Blood drawn or finger pricked for HIV, Hep C and syphilis.

Results

Rapid test results for HIV, Hep C and syphilis. Get a confirmatory test (blood draw) ASAP.

2 – 3 Days

Swab results for chlamydia and gonorrhea and rapid Herpes

5 – 7 Days

Results

Urine test results for chlamydia and gonorrhea.

Blood draw test results for HIV, Hep C and syphilis. Results for non-rapid Herpes swab tests.

WHO SHOULD GET TESTED

If you've been notified as a contact to someone who has tested positive, test for:

If you've ever shared a needle (for drug use or piercing or tattoos) with someone, test for:

HIV

If you've had unprotected (no condom) sexual contact, test for:

HIV

If were born between the years 1945 – 1975, test for:

If you're pregnant, test for:

Partner Notification

If you test positive for an STI or STBBI your sexual partners MUST be warned of possible exposure. Luckily, you don't have to do this. Upon testing positive, a nurse will follow up with the people you name as contacts OR visit https://tellyourpartner.org to send an anonymous text


Incubation

The incubation period of an infection is the time it takes between when you're exposed and when you develop symptoms

Window

The window period of an infection is the time between when you become infected and when a test can detect the infection.

ROCK PAINTING

What you'll need:

- Rocks with smooth surfaces
- Paintbrushes
- Acrylic Paint
- Pencils
- Water
- Spray on Paint Sealer (optional)

Ladybugs





- Paint the entire rock one fun color
- Paint a black half circle on one end of the rock 2.
- Paint a line down the middle, away from the half circle and give the ladybug some black spots all over the color
- 4. Paint two white dots on the black half circle and two even smaller dots on top of the white dots.



Stained Glass











- Sketch out the outline of the scene in pencil
- From the tip of the wave to the bottom, start with your lightest blue and move to the darkest
- 3. Paint the base ocean a medium blue
- Alternate between yellow and orange for the sun beams
- Outline each colour in black (use a sharpie if you like!)



Dot Mandalas







- Paint a large black circle in the middle of the rock
- Using the eraser at the end of the pencil, make a medium blue dot at the top, bottom, left and right of the black circle and fill in more blue dots between
- Make large, light blue dots right outside the last dots.
- Make rings of small, dark blue dots leading to one big blue dot in the middle.
- Make little white dots in the middle of each blue dot and between the medium blue dots
- Outline the large blue dots with little white ones & make lines of shrinking small white dots between the large blue ones
